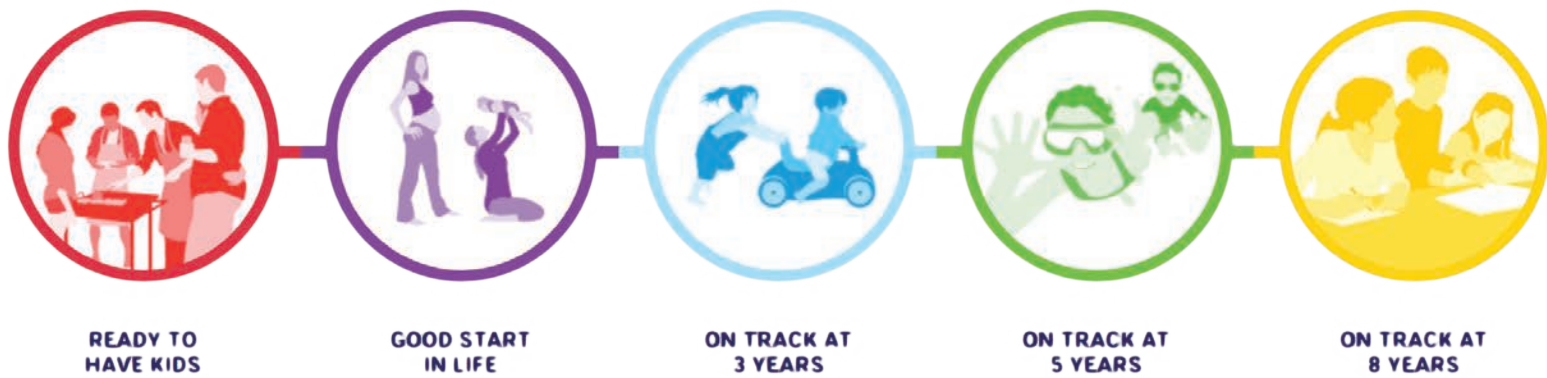

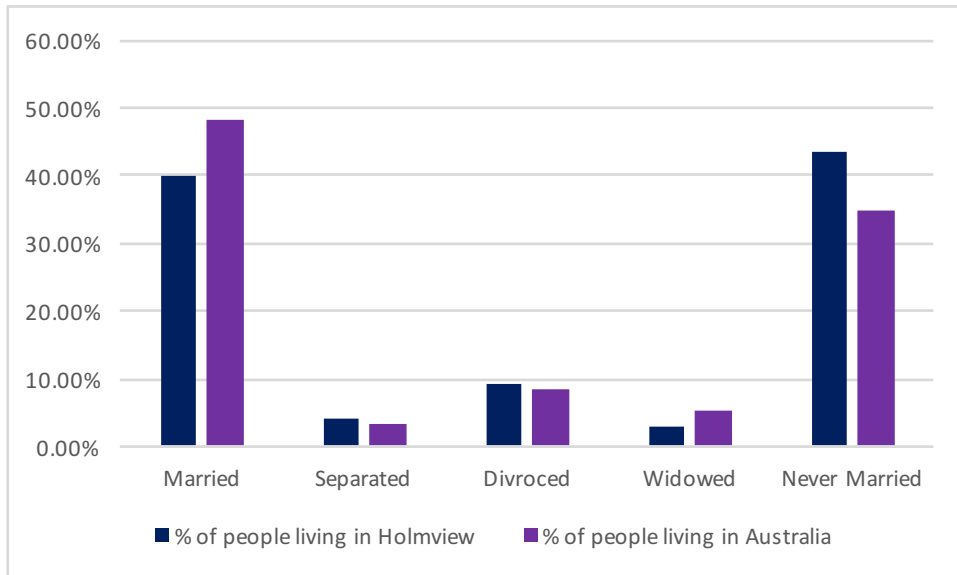

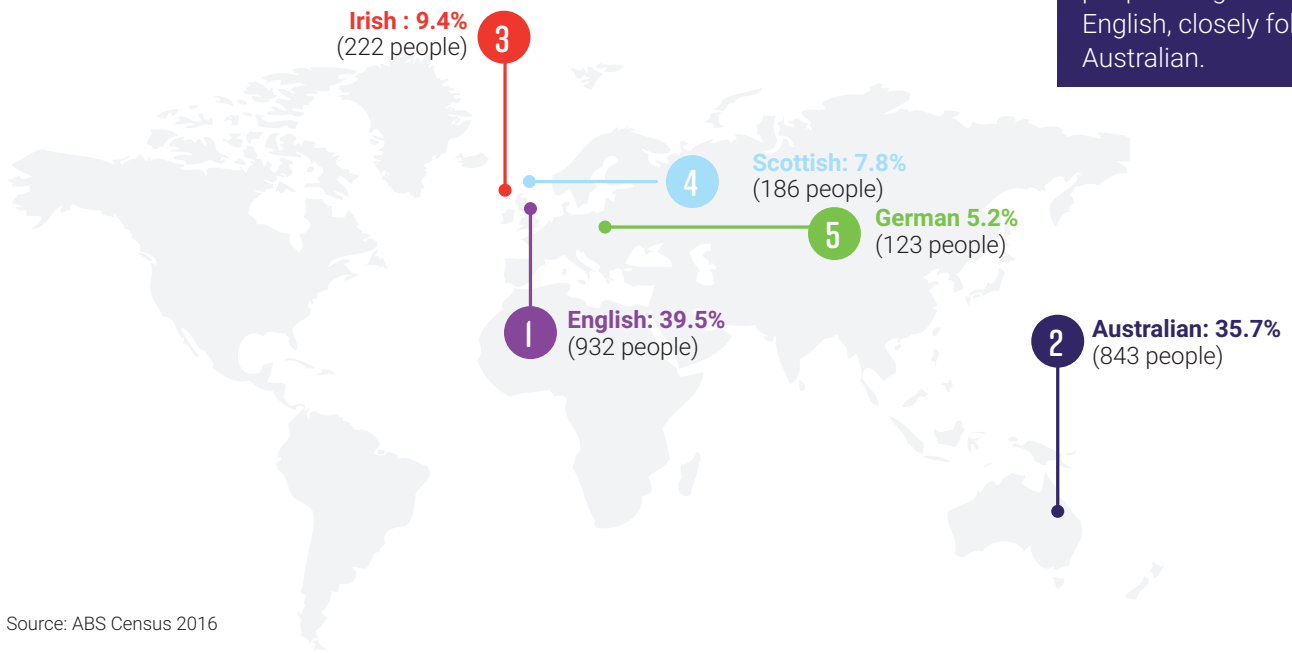


FIGURE 3: COUNTRY OF BIRTH OF PEOPLE LIVING IN HOLMVIEW

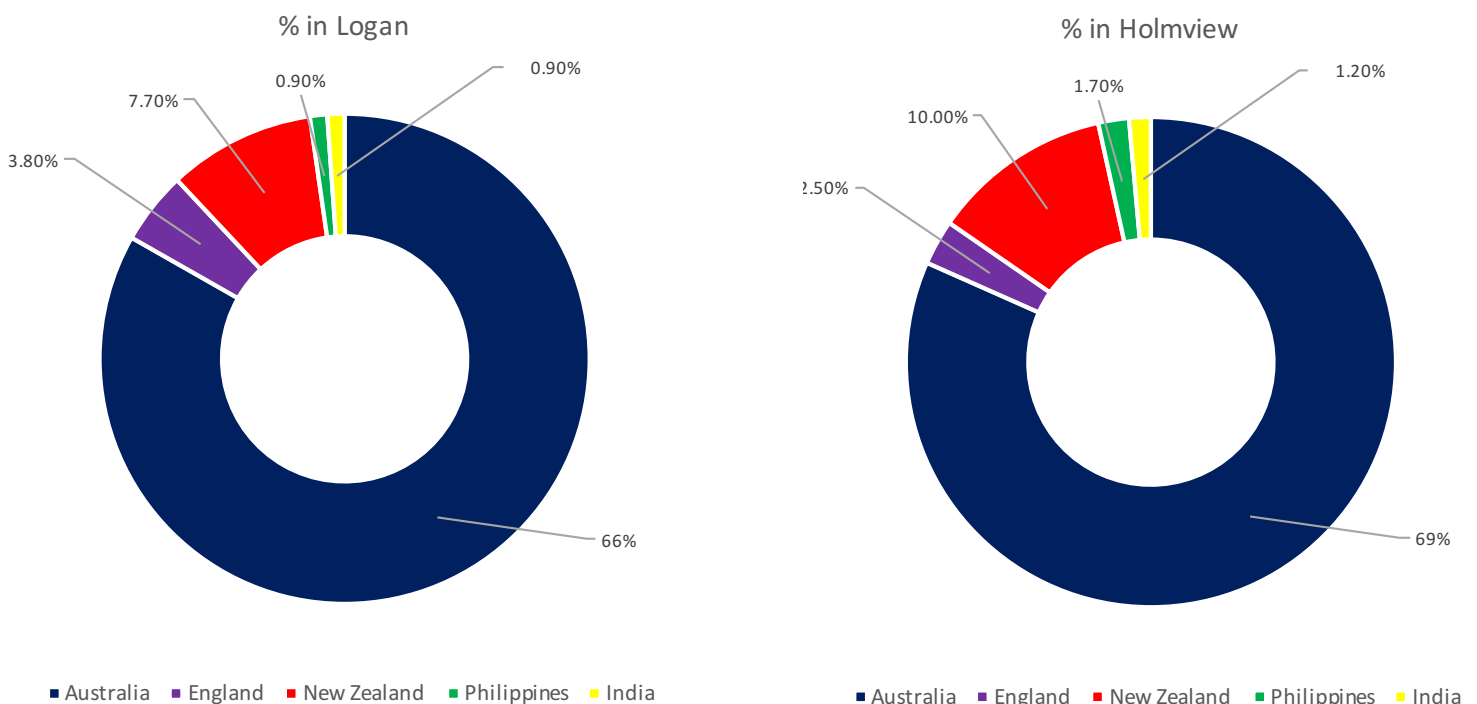


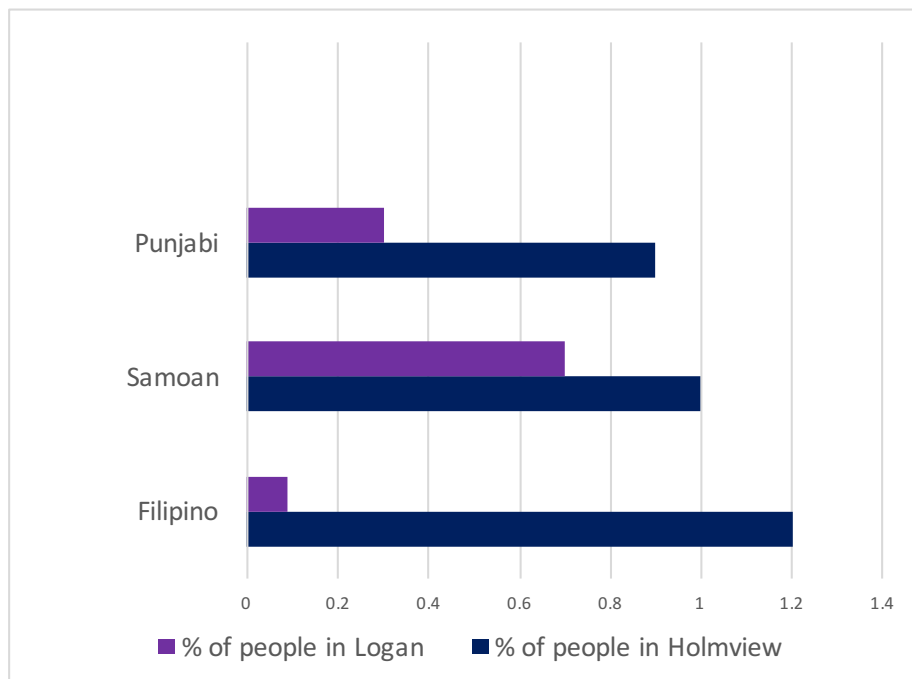

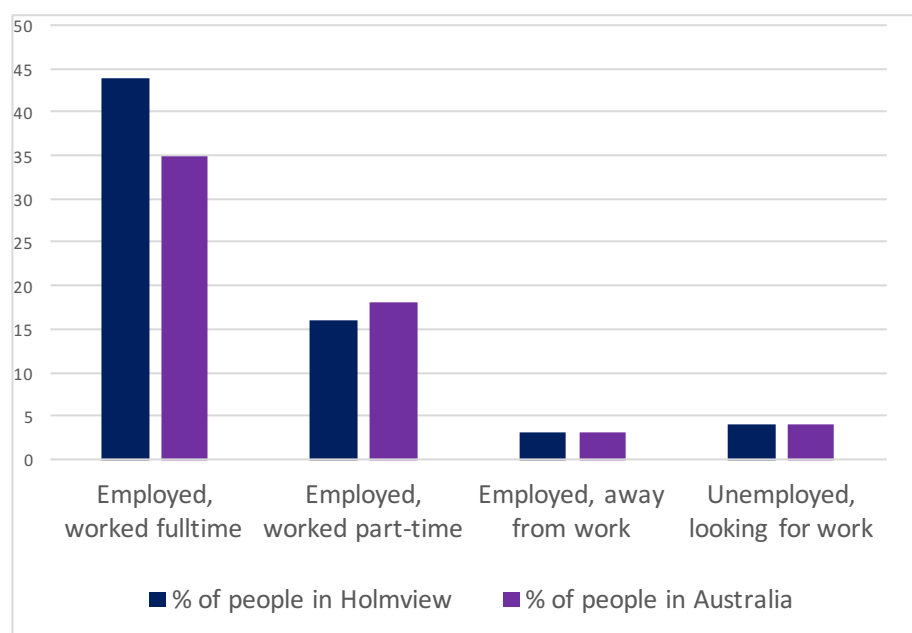

FIGURE 6: TOTAL WEEKLY INCOME OF FAMILIES IN HOLMVIEW

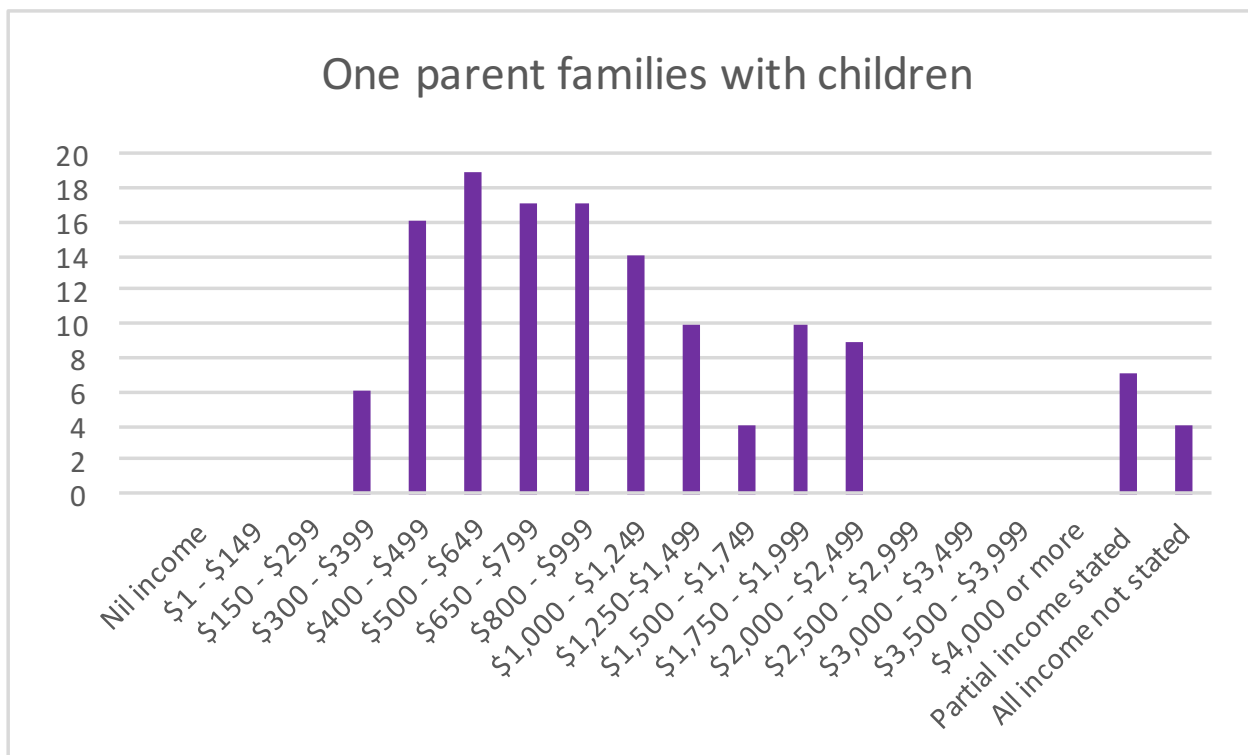
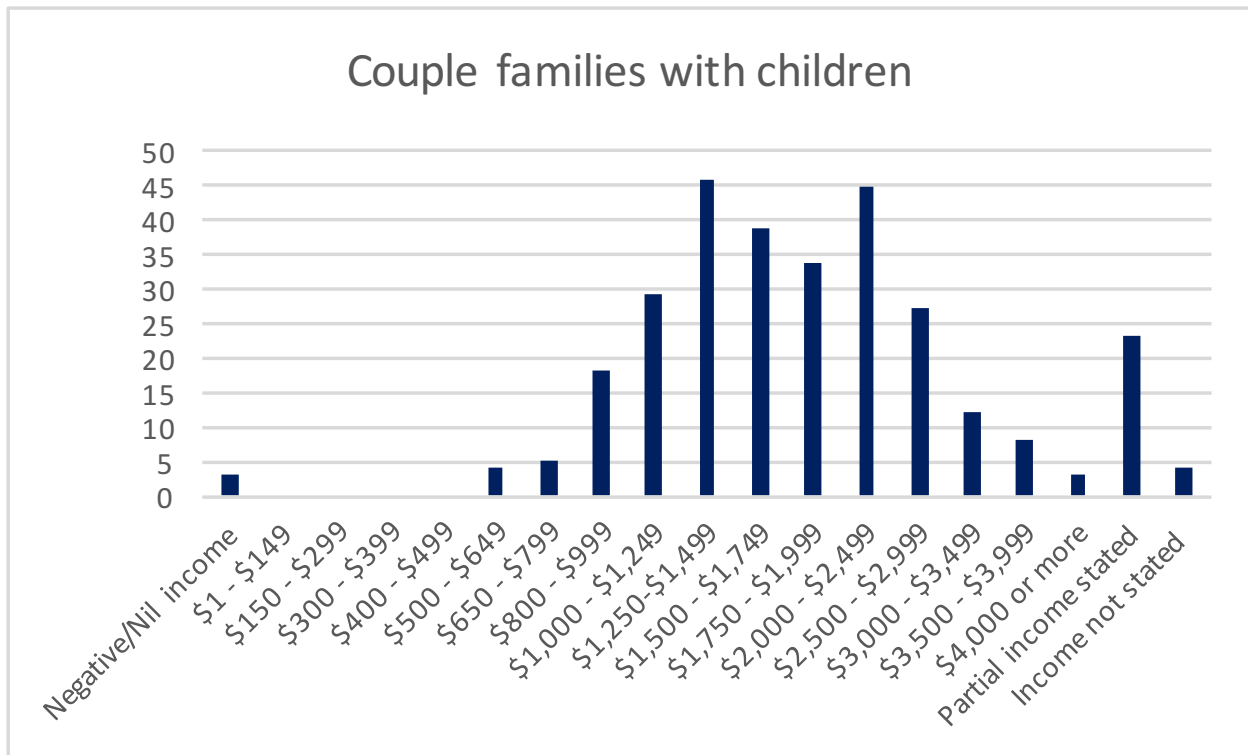

FIGURE 7: NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY DWELLING

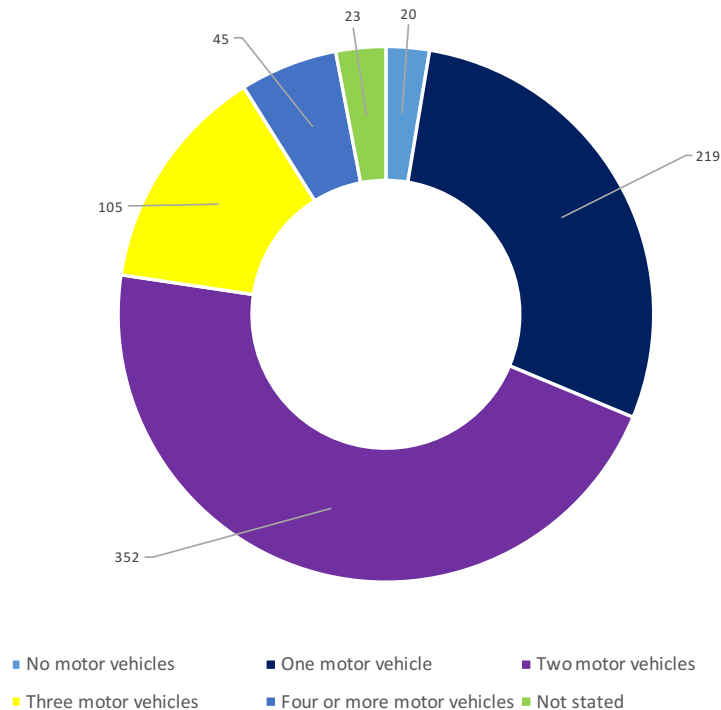
