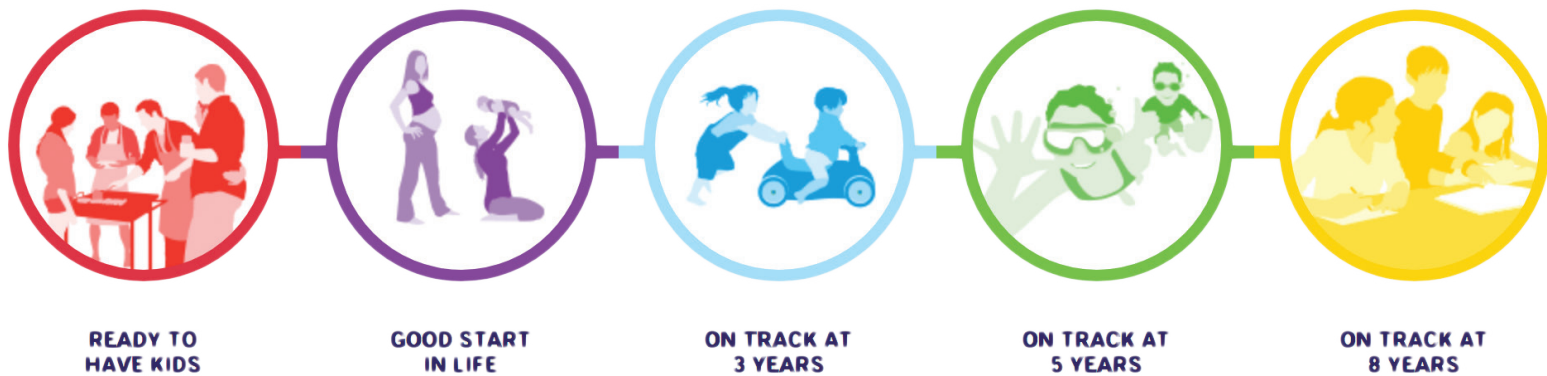

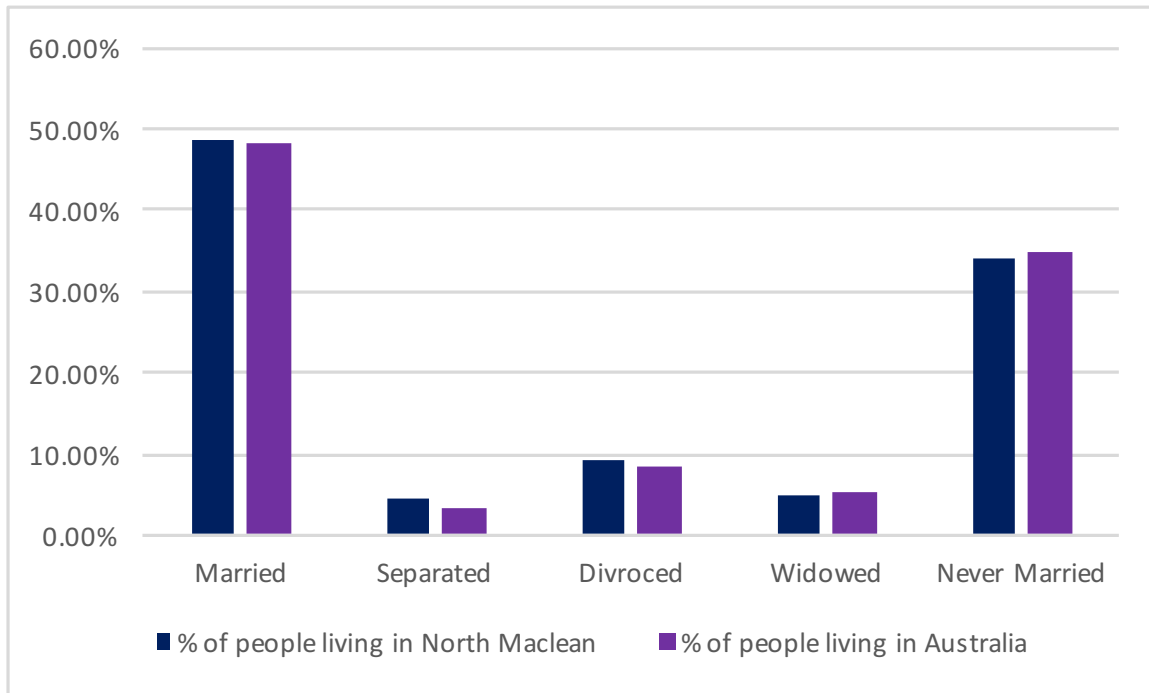

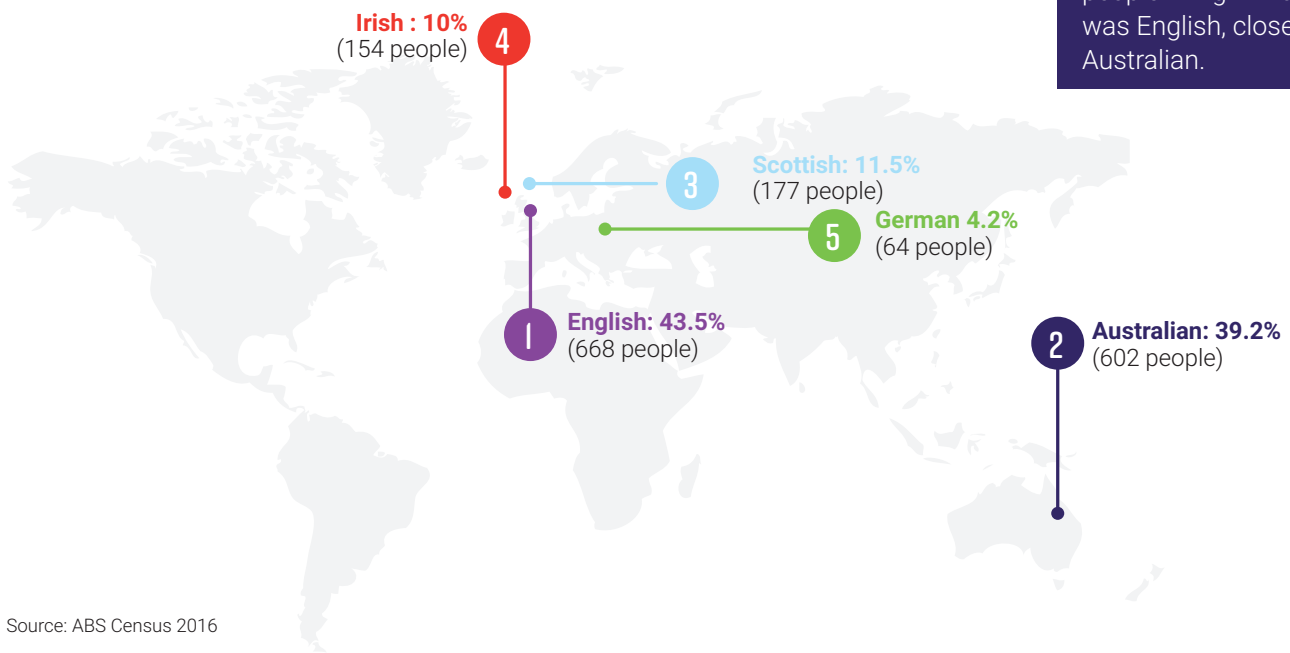


FIGURE 3: COUNTRY OF BIRTH OF PEOPLE LIVING IN NORTH MACLEAN

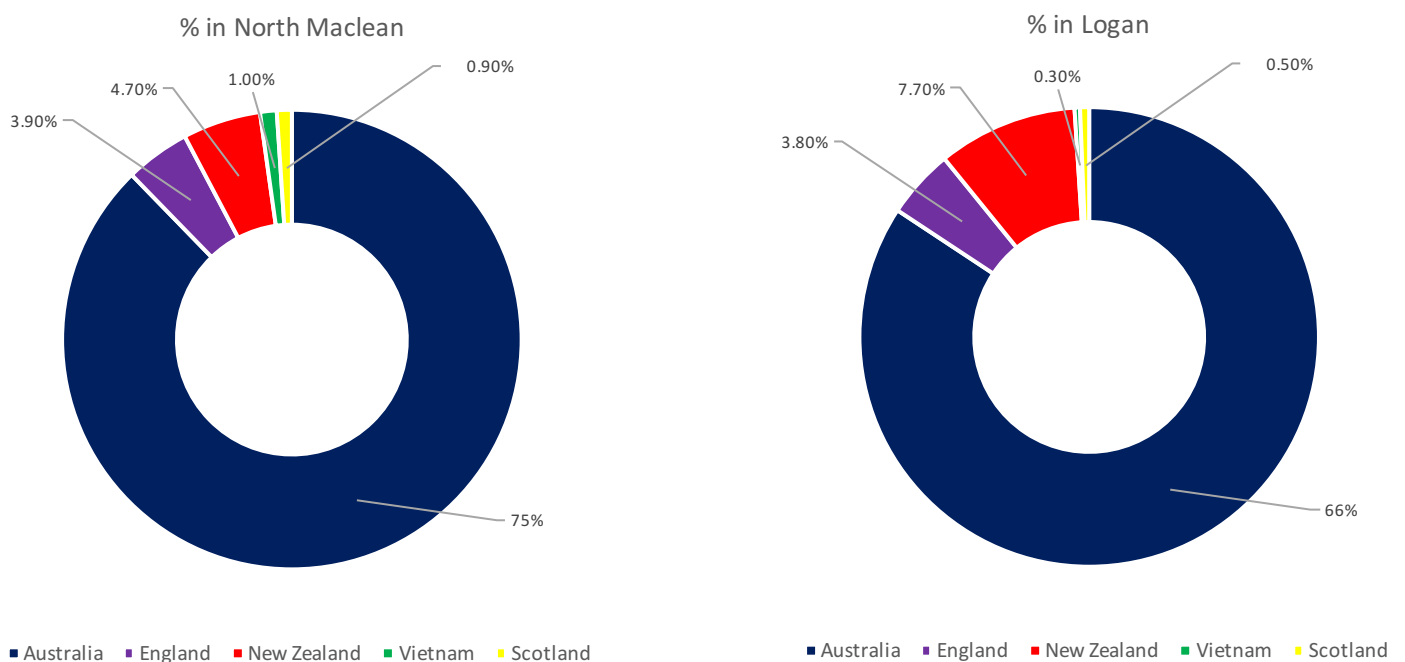


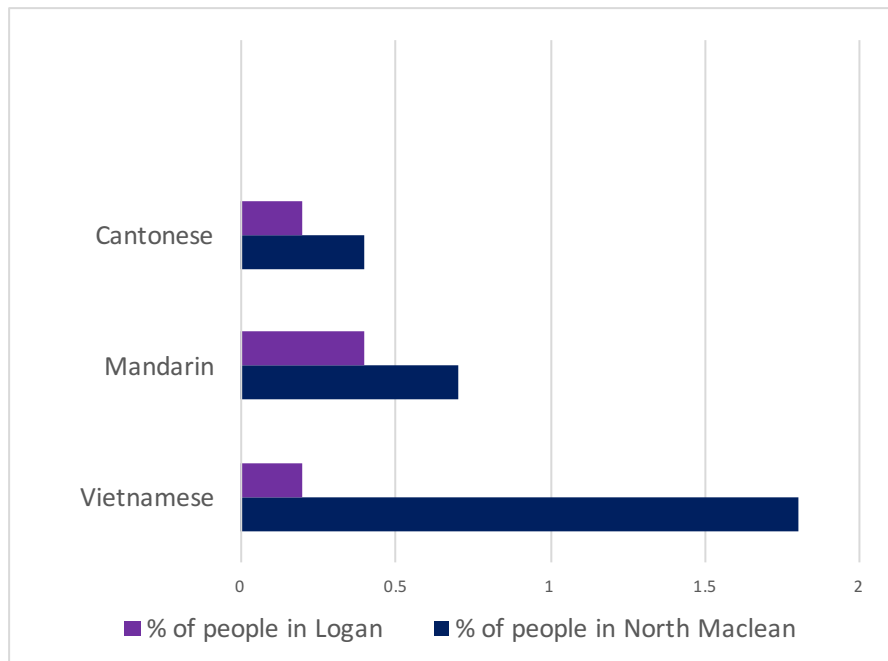

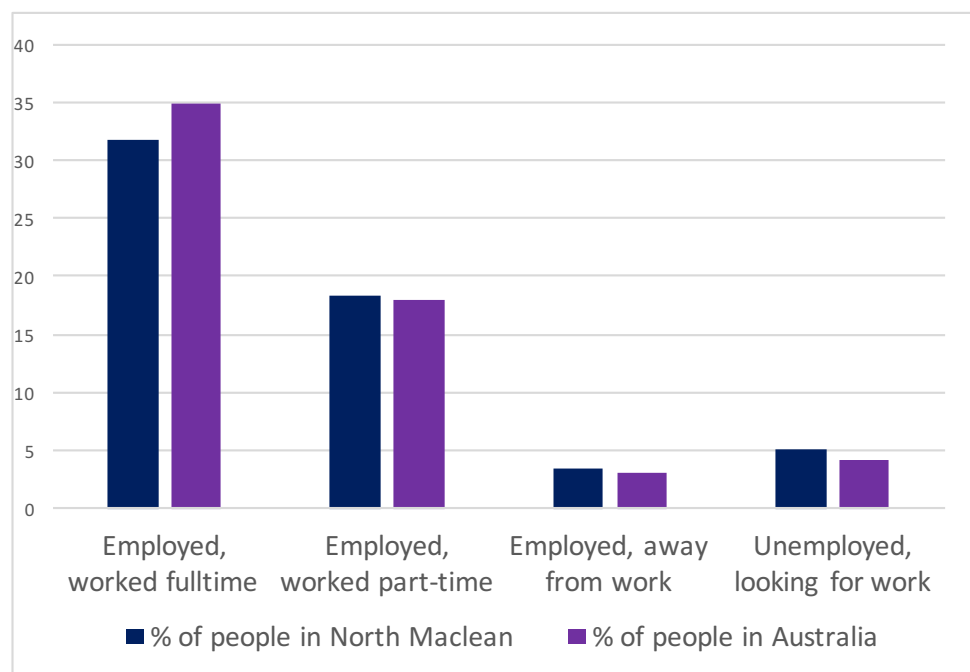

FIGURE 6: TOTAL WEEKLY INCOME OF FAMILIES IN NORTH MACLEAN

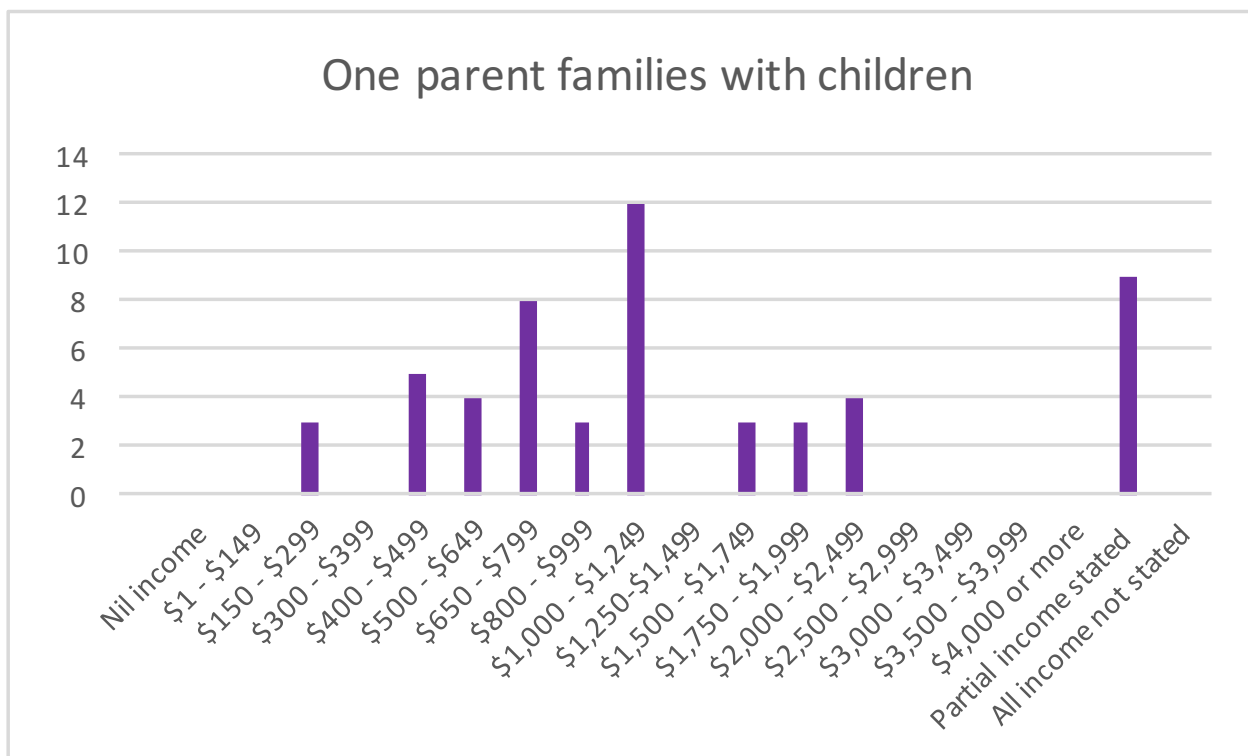
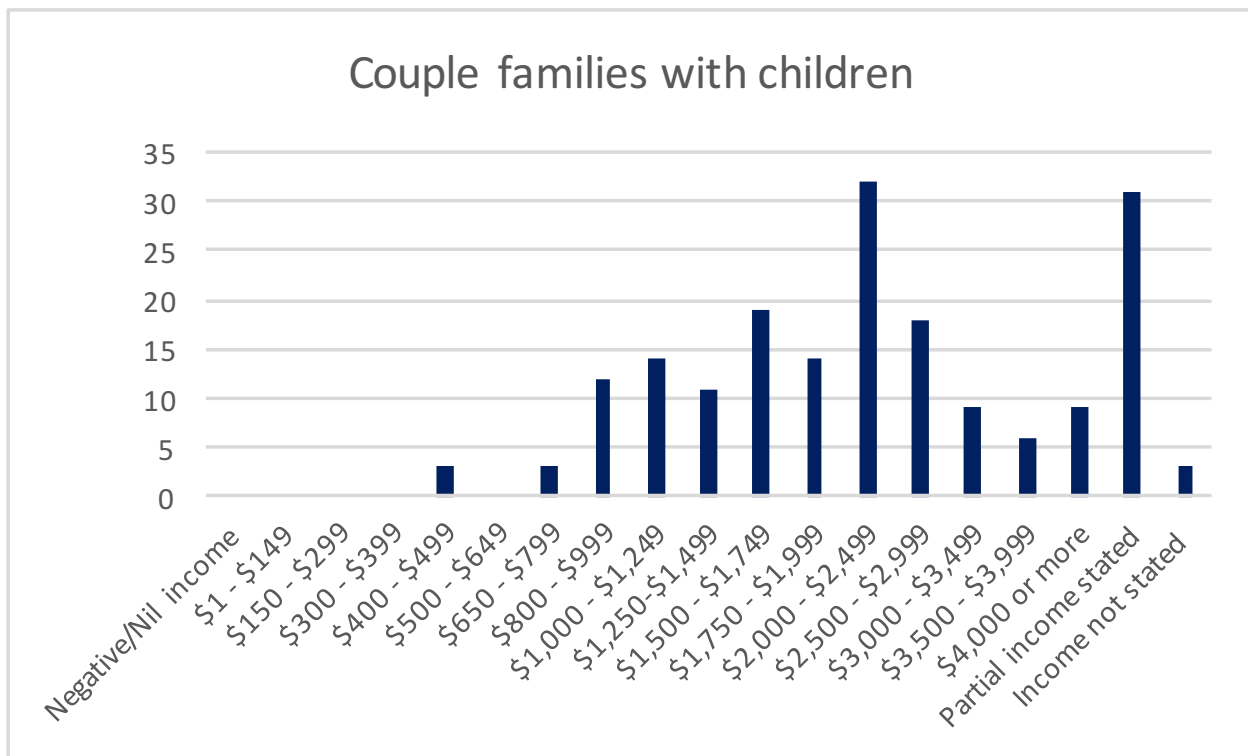

FIGURE 7: NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY DWELLING

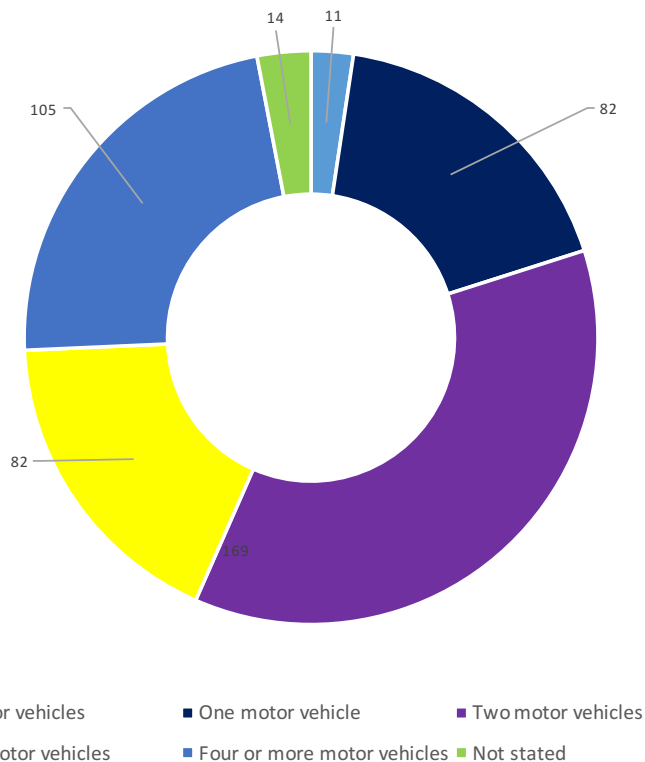
