








INTRODUCTION






FIGURE 3: COUNTRY OF BIRTH OF PEOPLE LIVING IN FORESTDALE






EARLY EDUCATION AND CARE

There are many different types of early education and care services. Most are regulated under the National Quality Framework (NQF) including; family day care, long day care, kindergarten/preschool and outside school hours care.

Regulated services are required to meet high national standards to ensure children are safe and are given opportunities for learning and development on a regular basis. These services are given quality ratings to help families choose the best service for their child and family.

The National Quality Framework introduced a new quality standard in 2012 to improve education and care across long day care, family day care, preschool/kindergarten, and outside school hours care services.

ECEC centres and NQS rating

Services are assessed against the 7 quality areas of the National Quality Standard (NQS) and given an overall rating based on these results.

The National Quality Framework includes the National Law and National Regulations, the National Quality Standard, an assessment and quality rating process and national learning frameworks.

The overall service ratings are:

- Excellent rating, awarded by ACECQA
- Exceeding National Quality Standard
- Meeting National Quality Standard
- Working towards National Quality Standard
- Significant Improvement Required

Services must display their ratings at the service at all times

The 7 quality areas of the National Quality Standard are:

- 1. Educational program and practice
- 2. Children's health and safety
- 3. Physical environment
- 4. Staffing arrangements
- 5. Relationships with children
- 6. Partnerships with families and communities
- 7. Leadership and service management

The following is a list of the Early Education and Care services currently available in Boronia Heights and their National Quality Standard (NQS) Ratings as at the time of writing.





FIGURE 6: TOTAL WEEKLY INCOME OF FAMILIES IN FORESTDALE





FIGURE 7: NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY DWELLING


