# INTRODUCTION

The following profile has been developed to support the analysis of population characteristics at a suburb level. In addition to population characteristics, there is a particular focus on children aged 0-8 years, with the Australian Early Development Census (AEDC) and Naplan data being included where available.

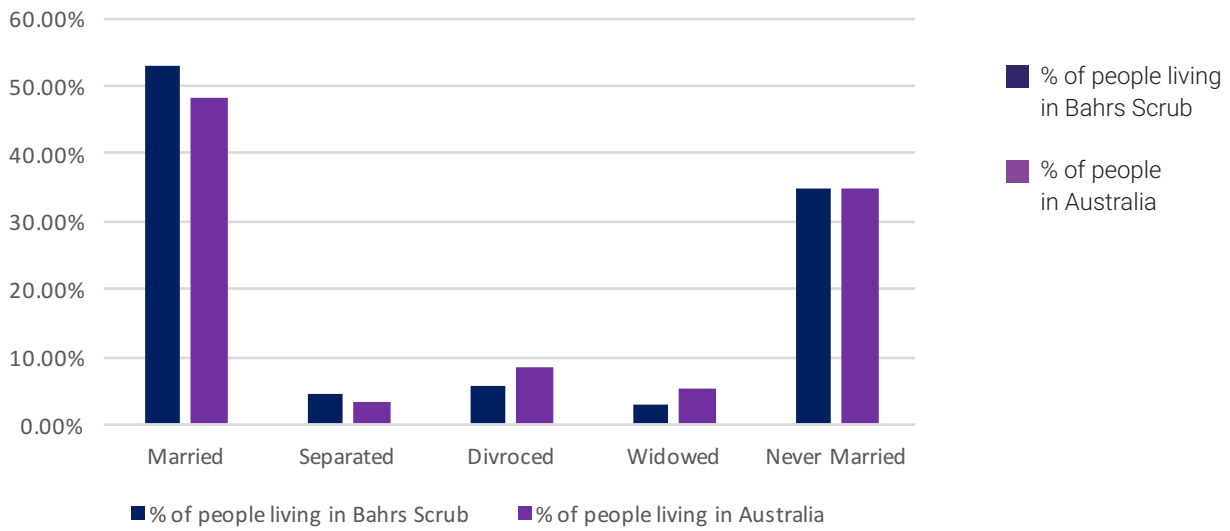

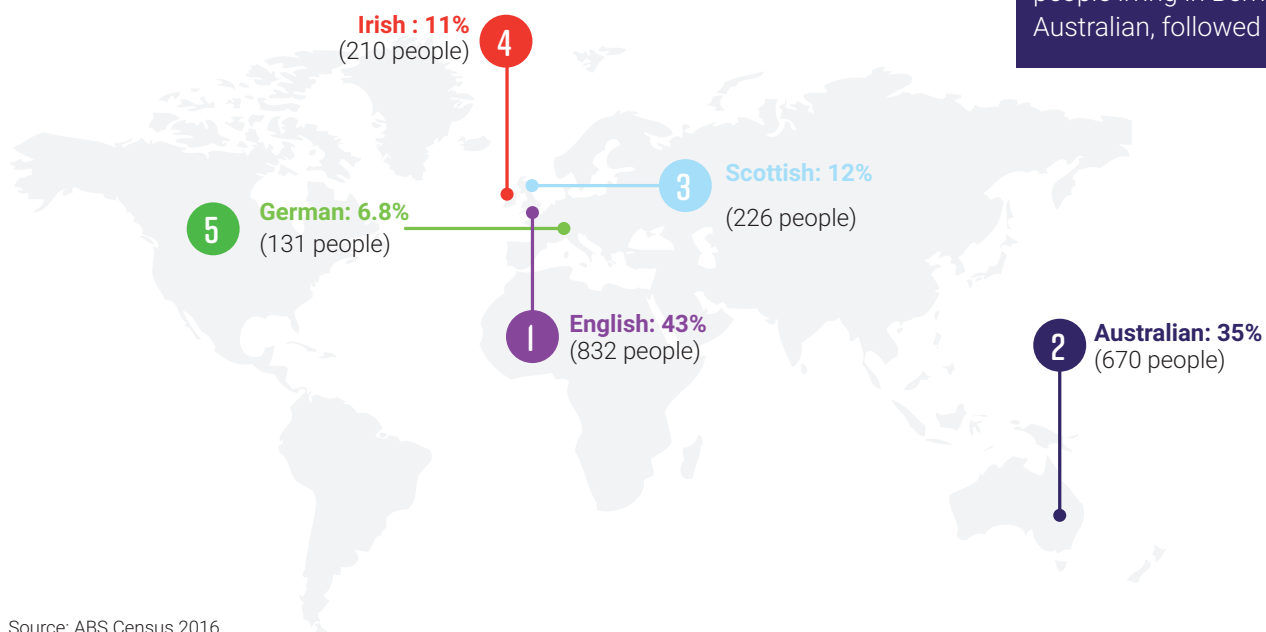

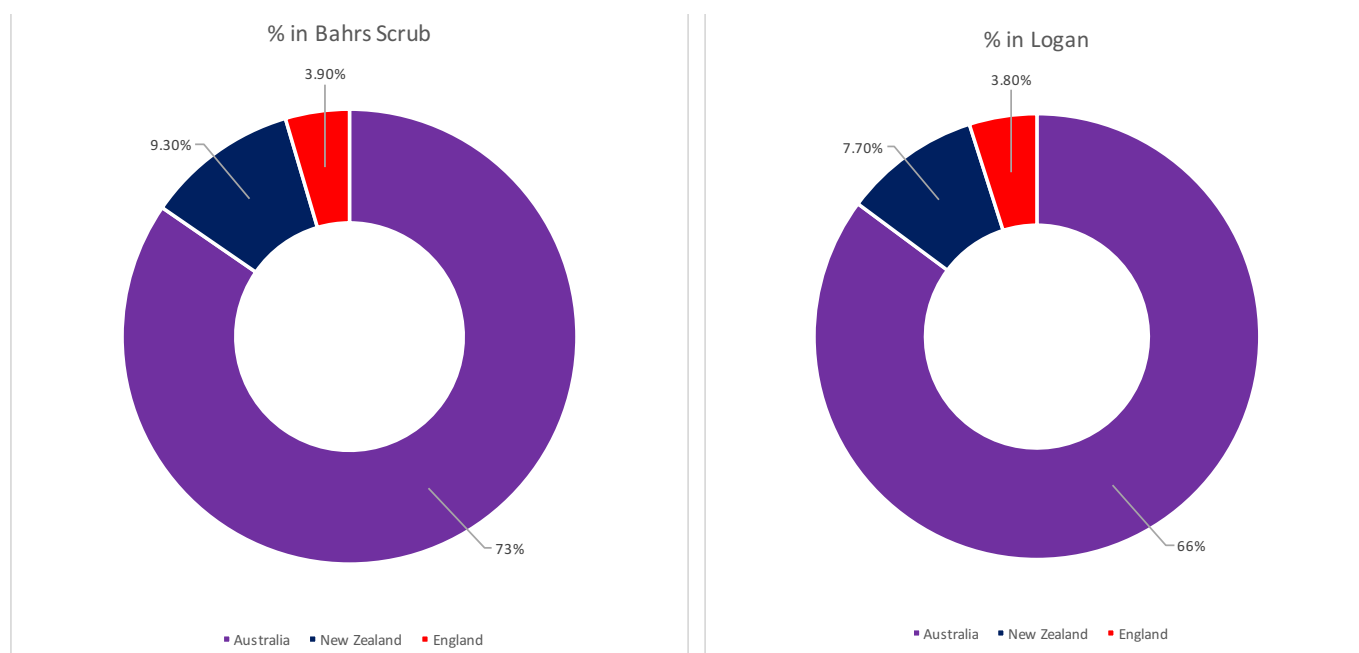

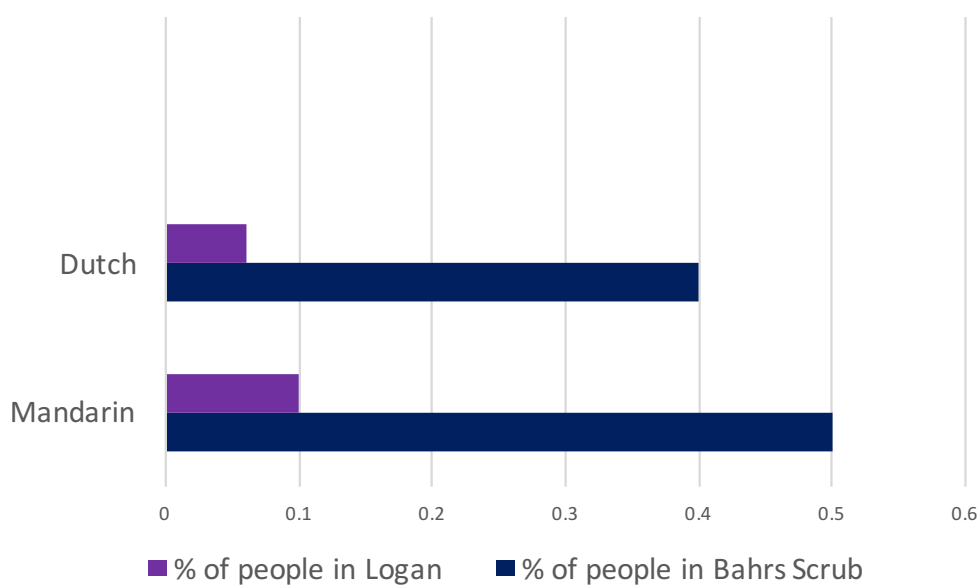

## SCHOOLS IN BAHR'S SCRUB

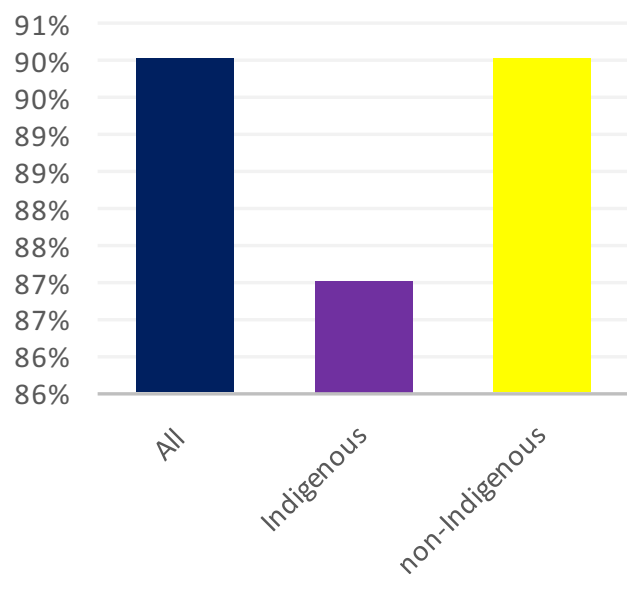

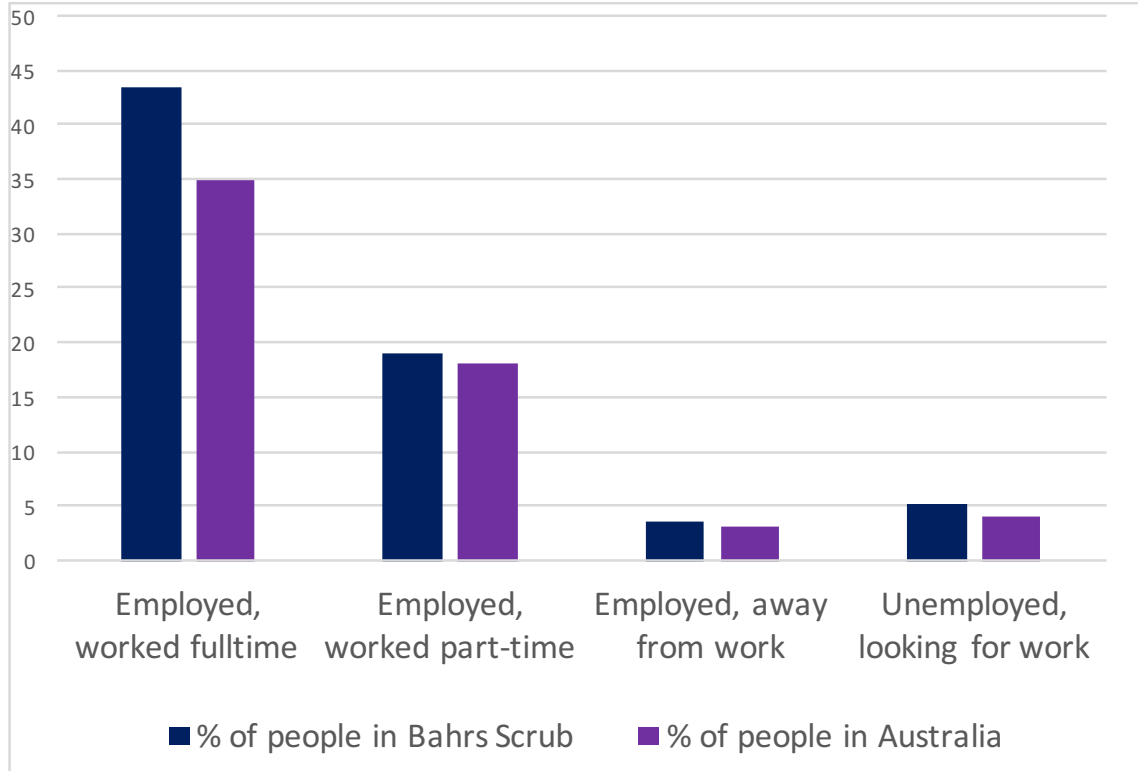

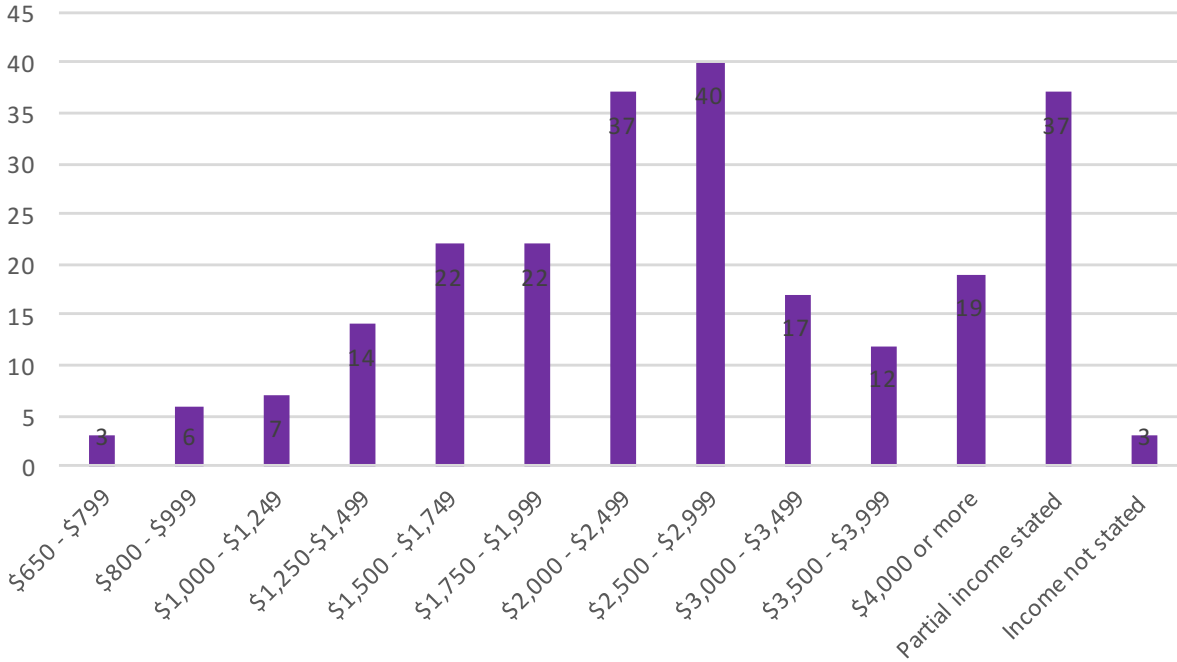

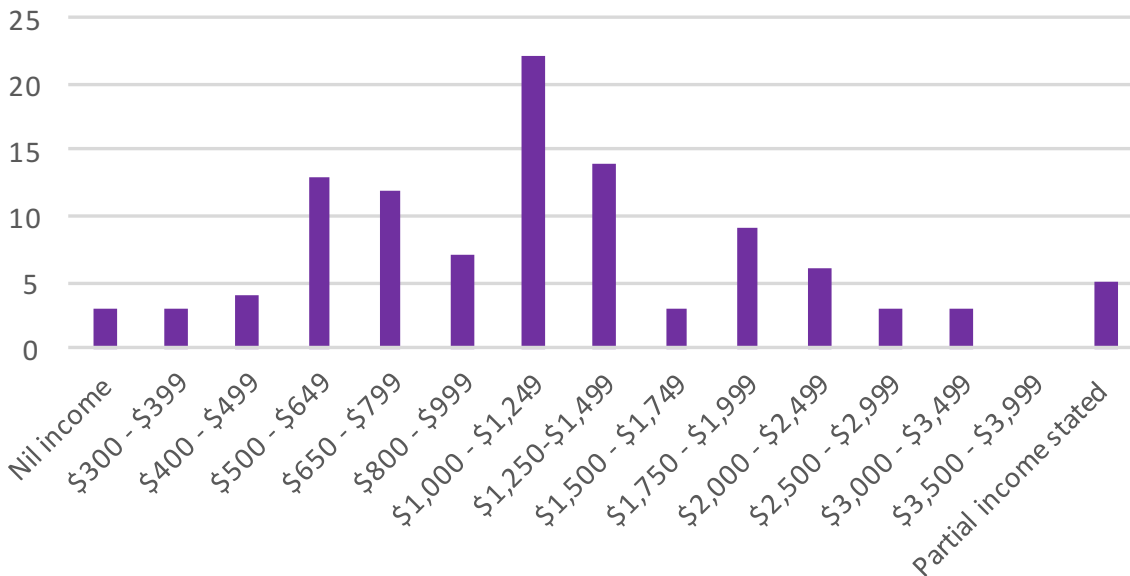

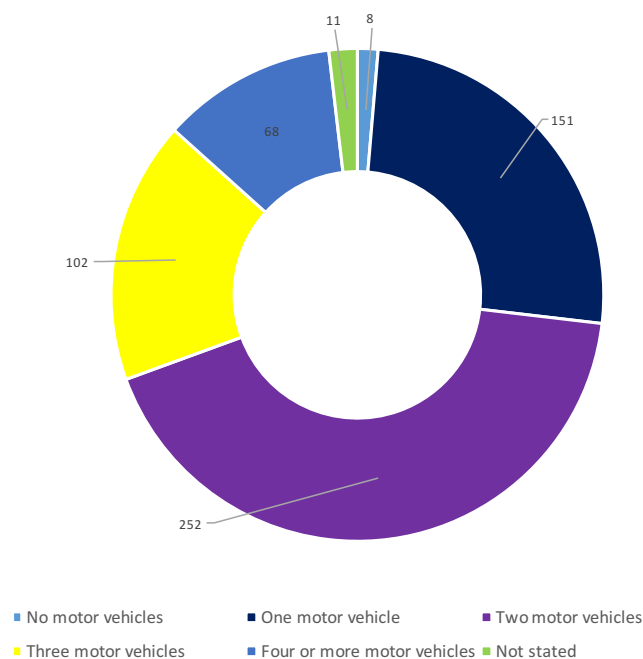
