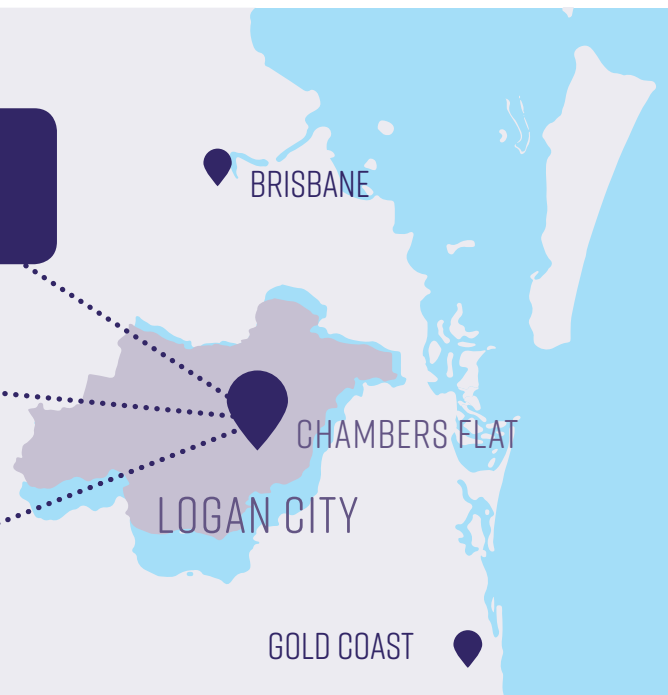

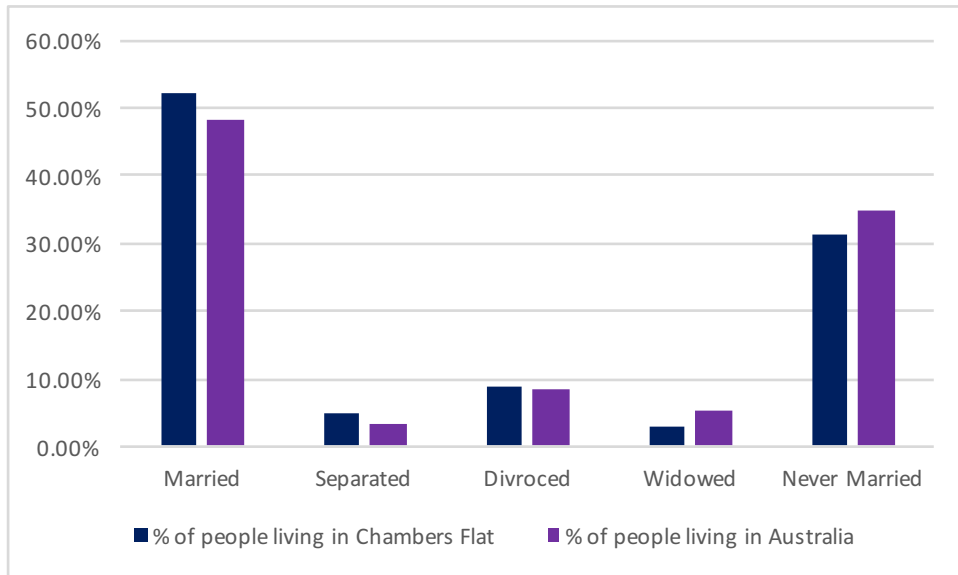

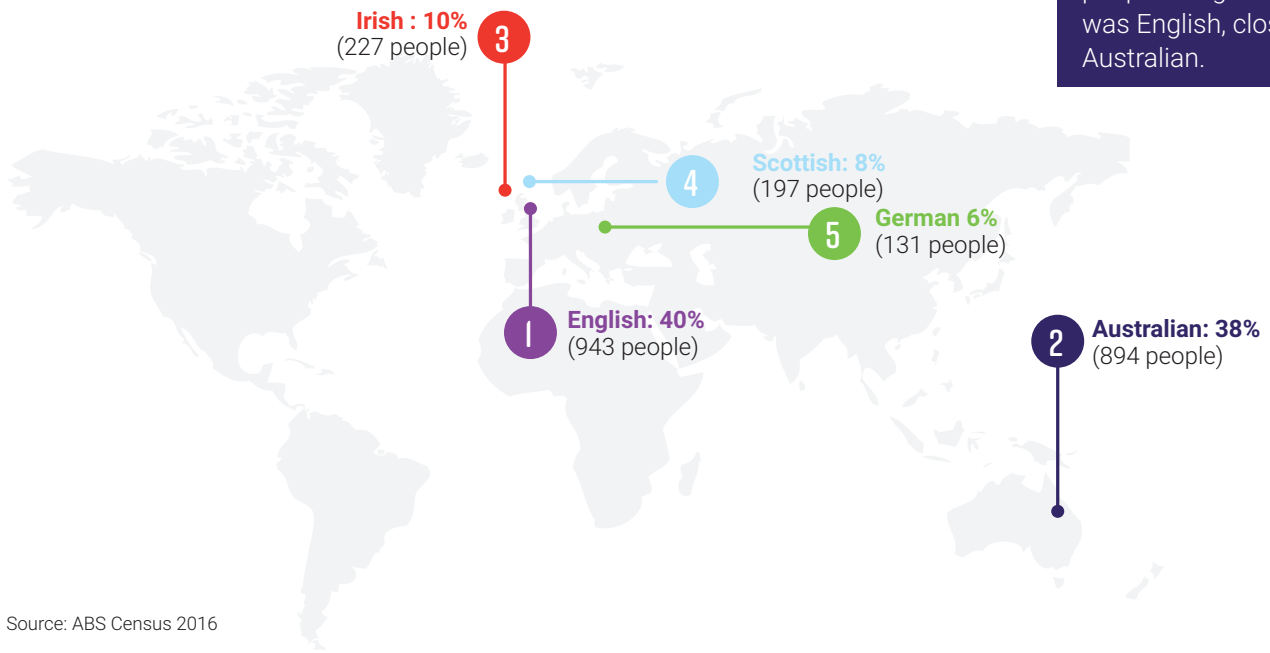


FIGURE 3: COUNTRY OF BIRTH OF PEOPLE LIVING IN CHAMBERS FLAT

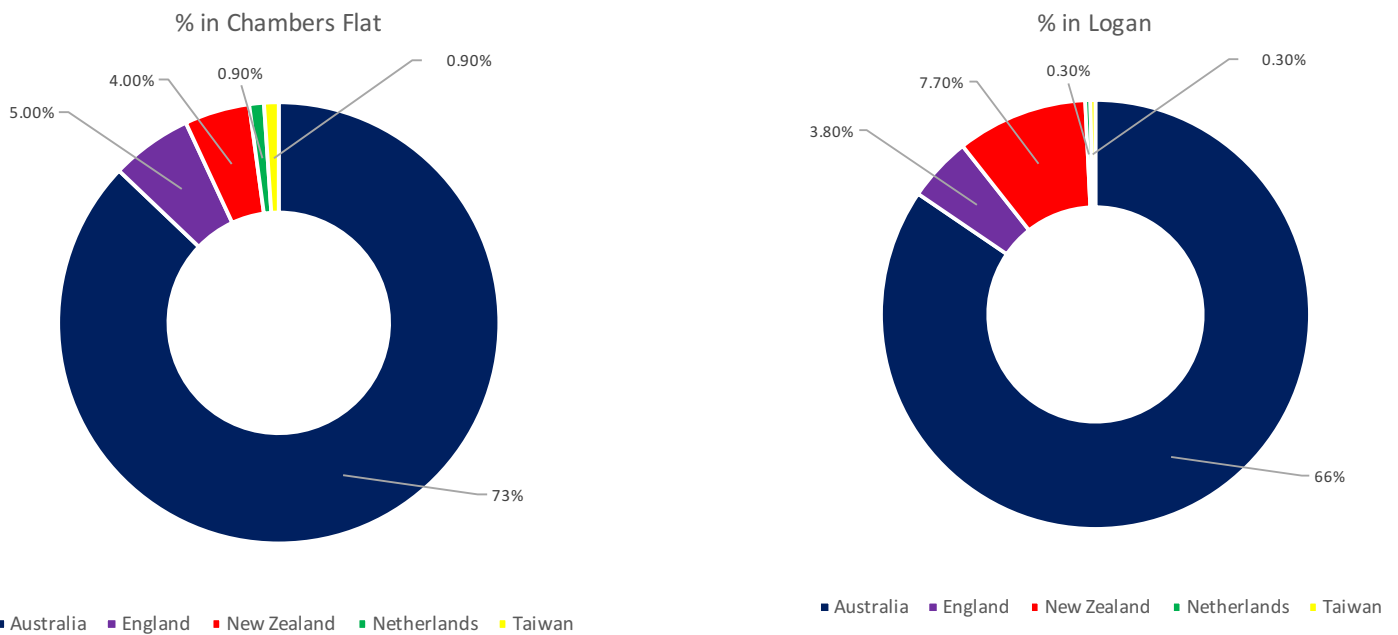


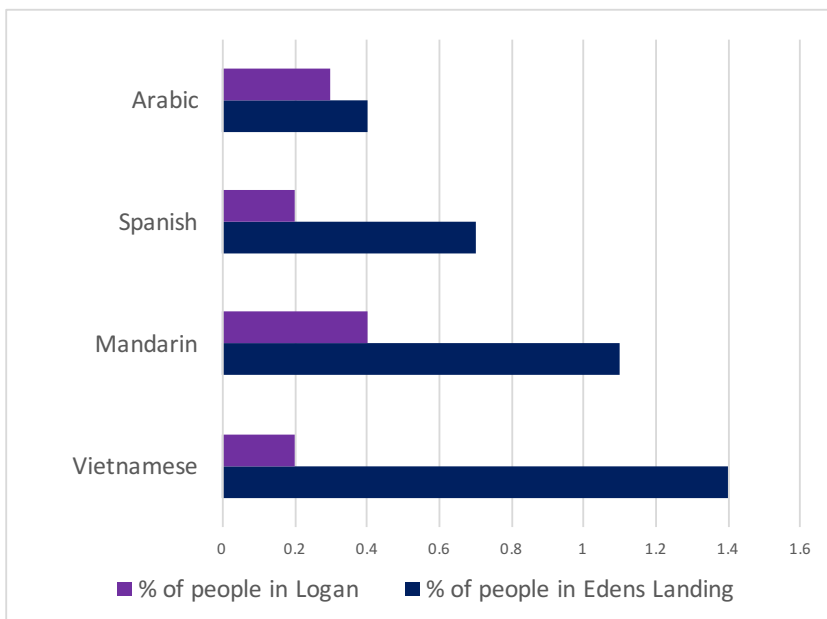

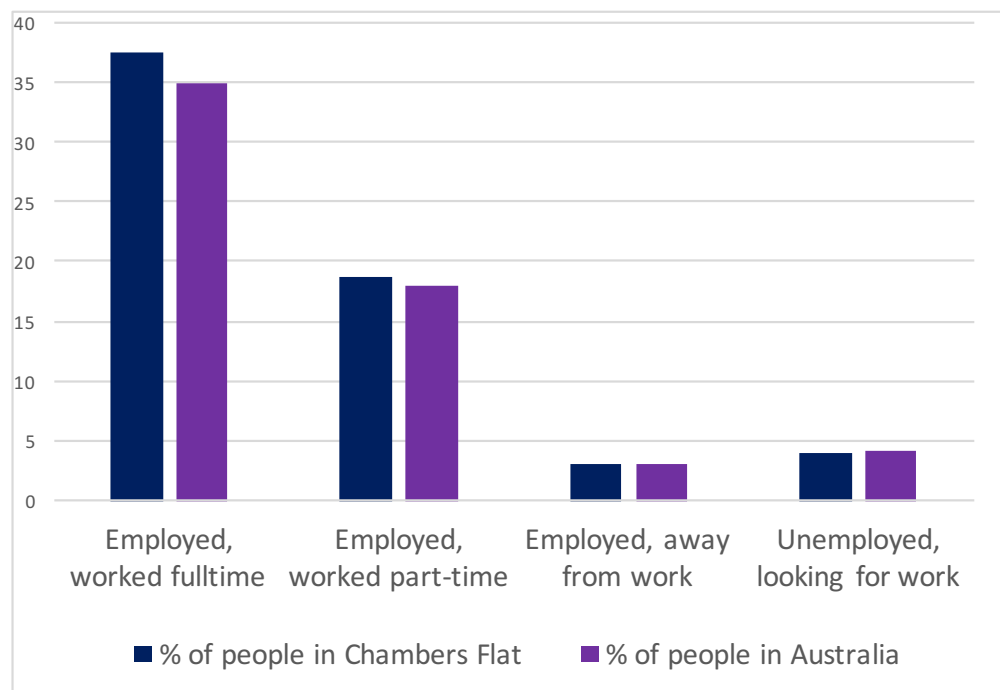

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FIGURE 6: TOTAL WEEKLY INCOME OF FAMILIES IN CHAMBERS FLAT

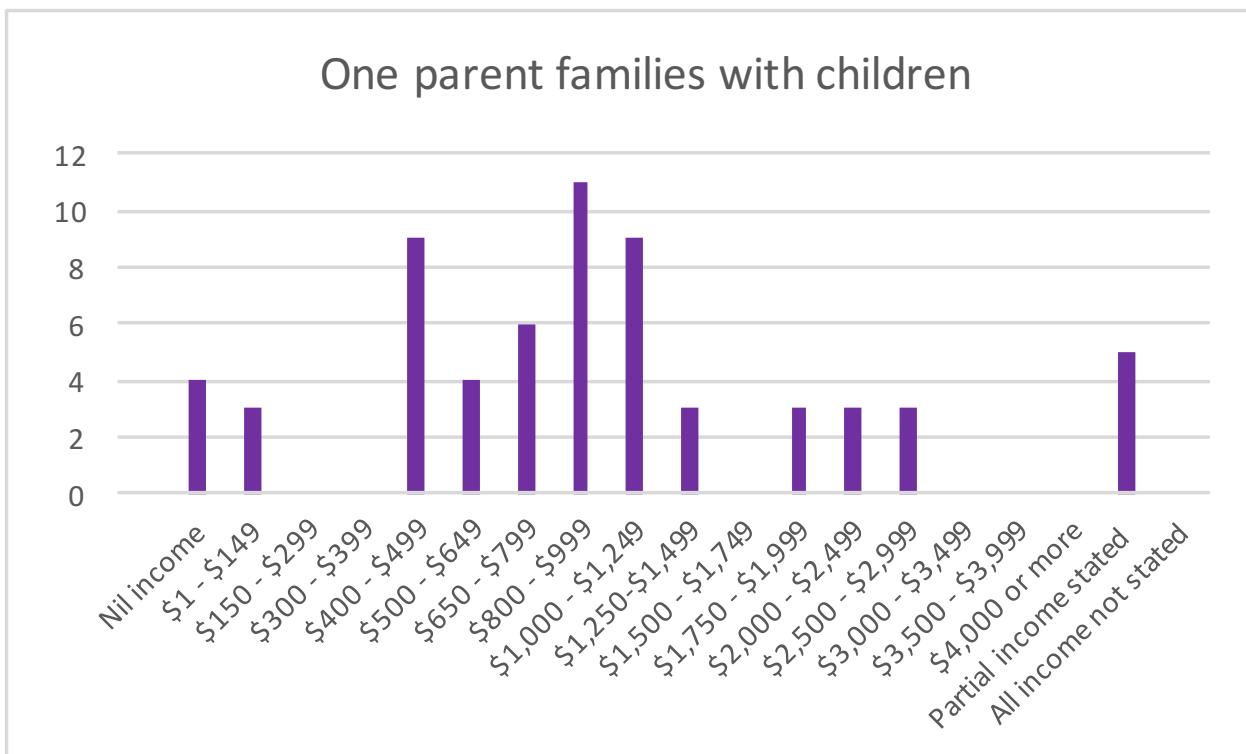
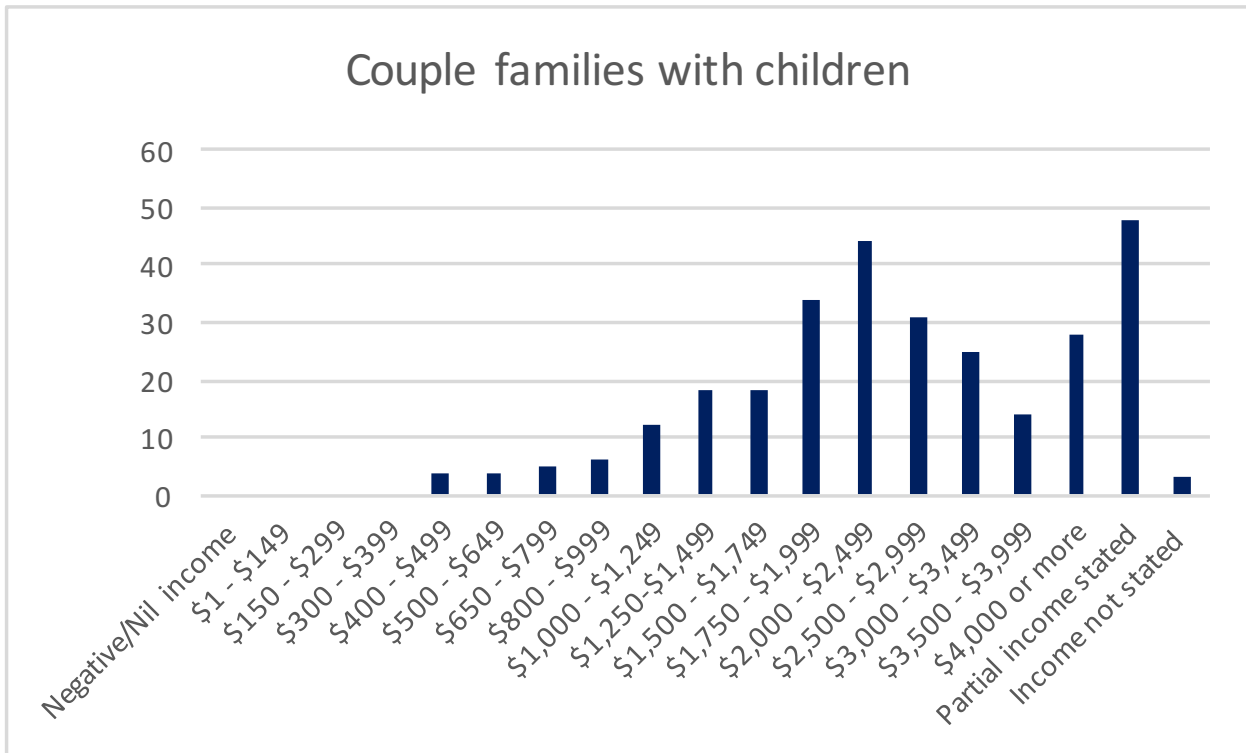

FIGURE 7: NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY DWELLING

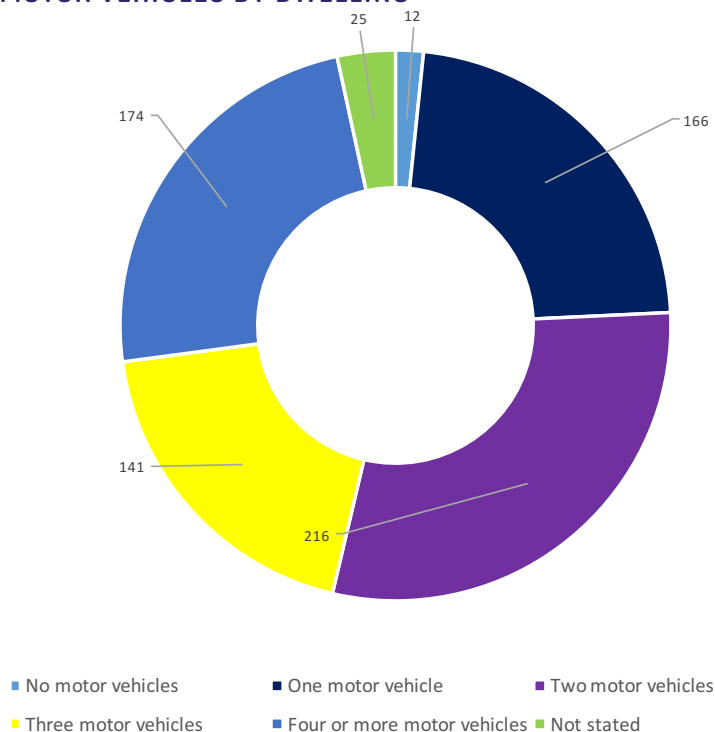
