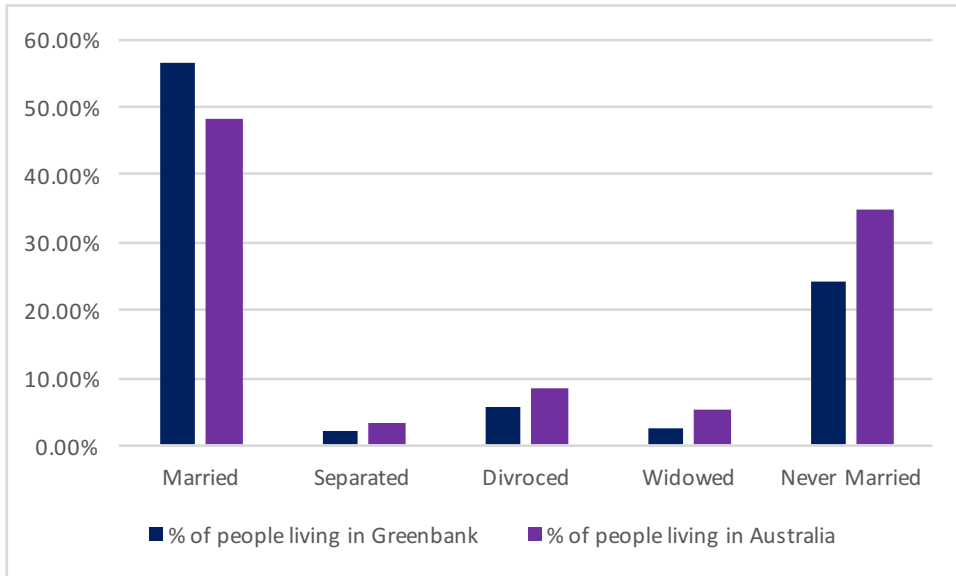

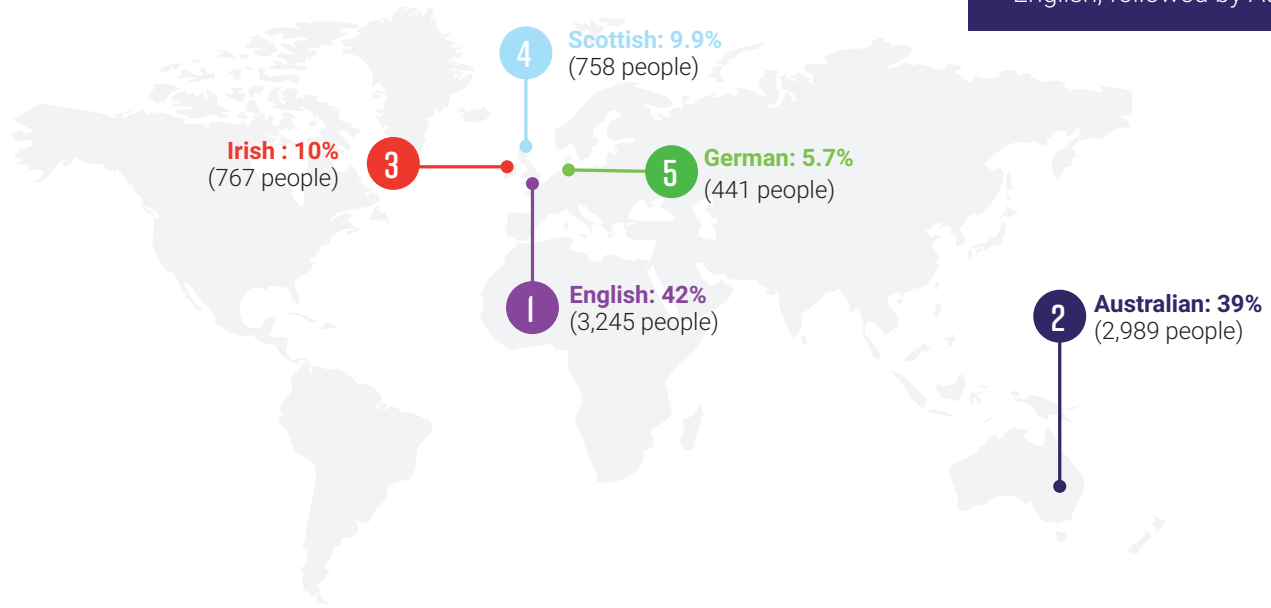

FIGURE 3: COUNTRY OF BIRTH OF PEOPLE LIVING IN GREENBANK (TOP 4 RESPONSES)

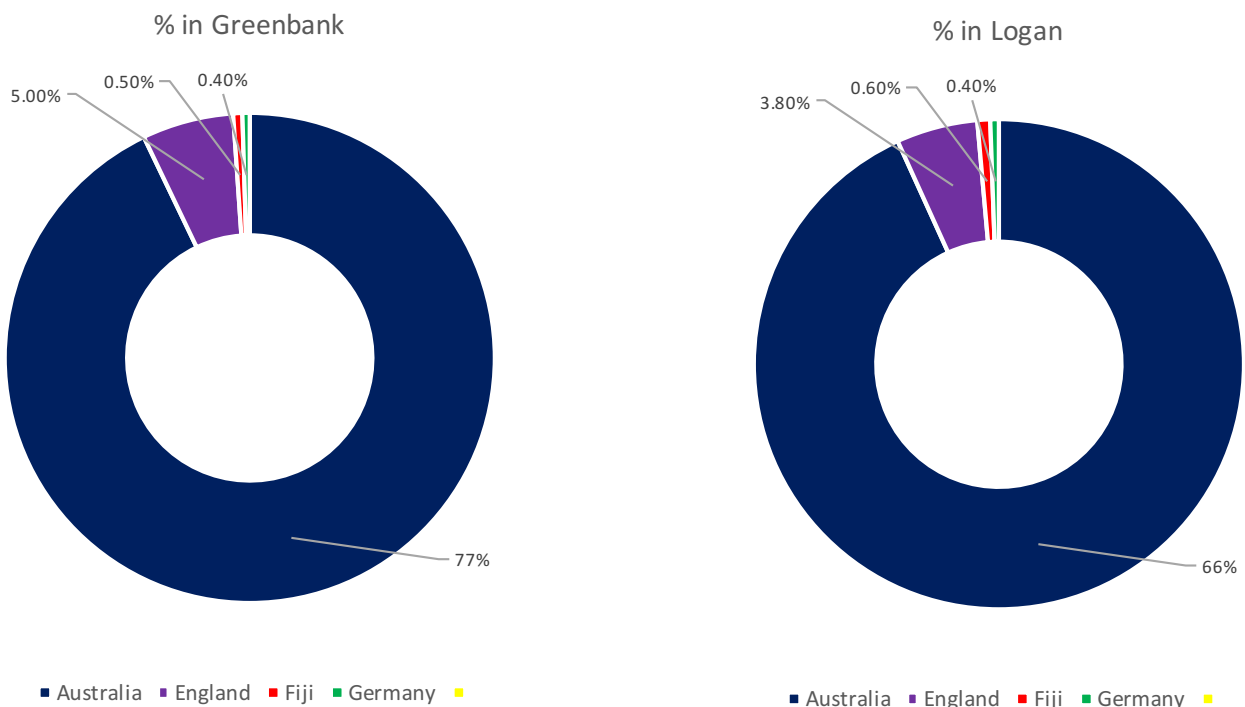


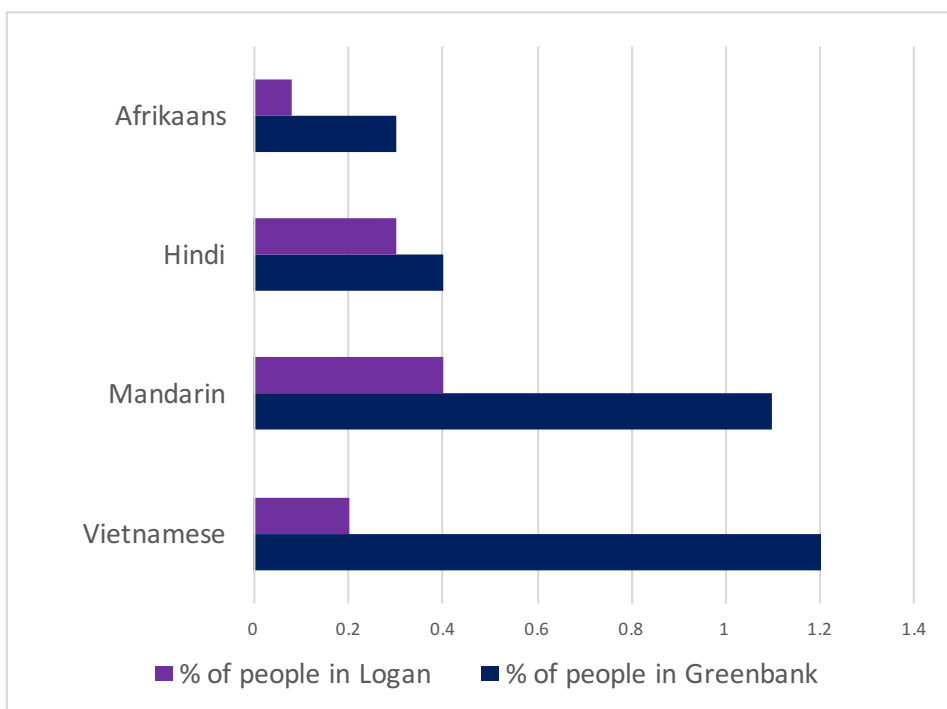

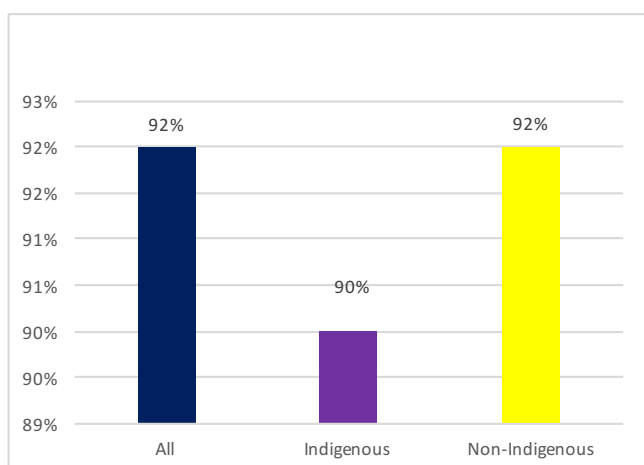

Greenbank State School was established in 1893 and provides education from Prep to Year 6 to an enrolment of over 1000 students. Students are engaged in curriculum which covers the eight Key Learning Areas with particular focus on Literacy, Numeracy, Integrated Studies and Environmental Education, the latter a key vehicle to the school's applied learning approach.

AUSTRALIAN EARLY DEVELOPMENT CENSUS (AEDC)

The AEDC is a nationwide measure that looks at how well children across Australia are growing up or ‘developing’.

The AEDC looks at five different elements or domains that are important for children’s development. These are: physical health and wellbeing, social competence, emotional maturity, language and cognitive skills (school-based); and communication skills and general knowledge.

The AEDC is collected every three years in schools across Australia. The data collection was completed in 2009, 2012 and 2015.

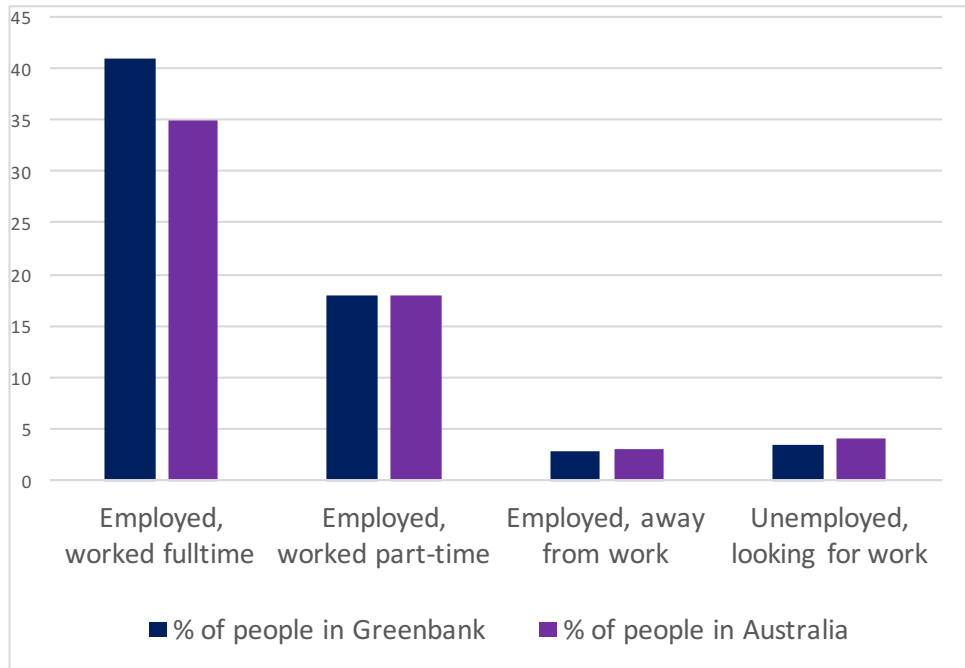

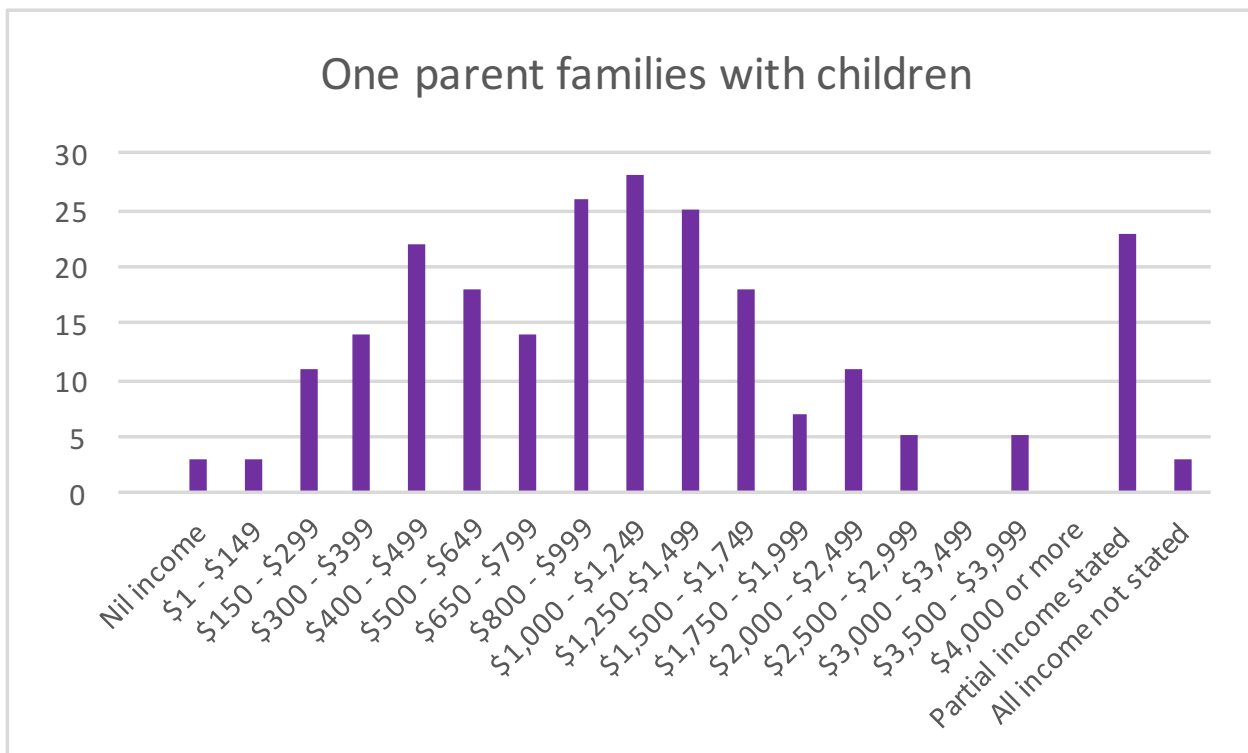
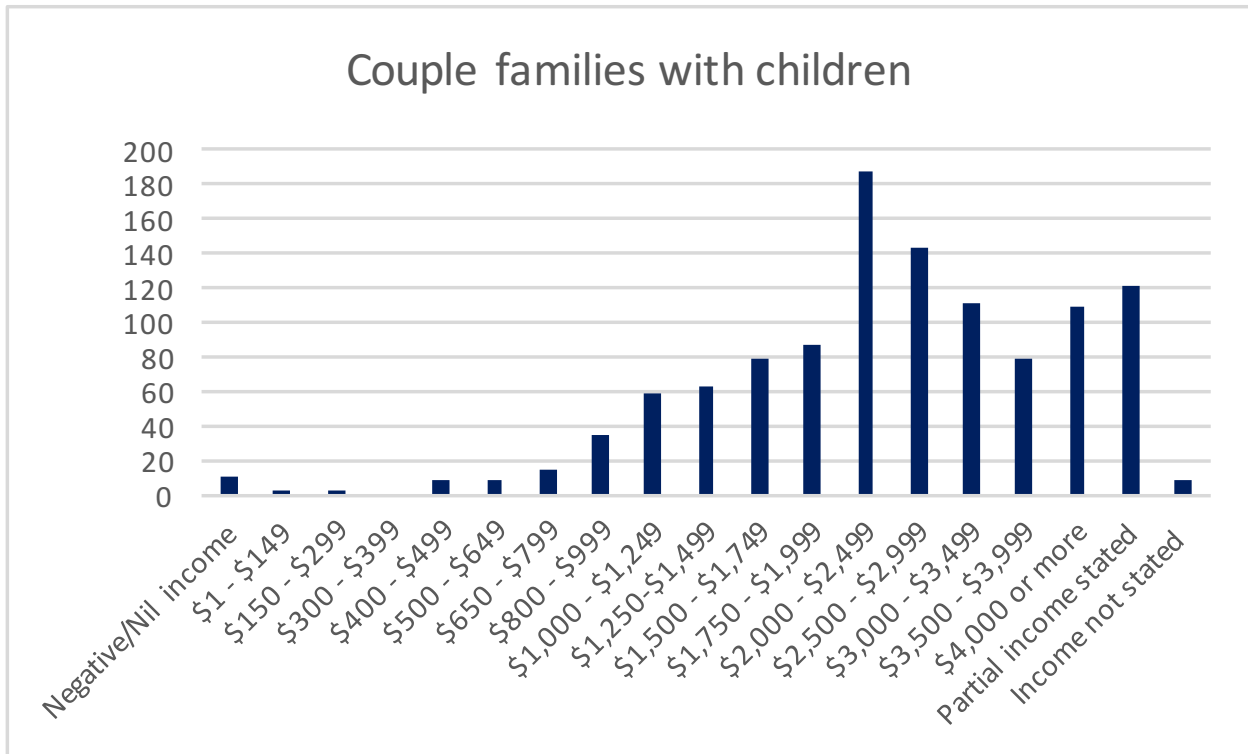

FIGURE 8: NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY DWELLING

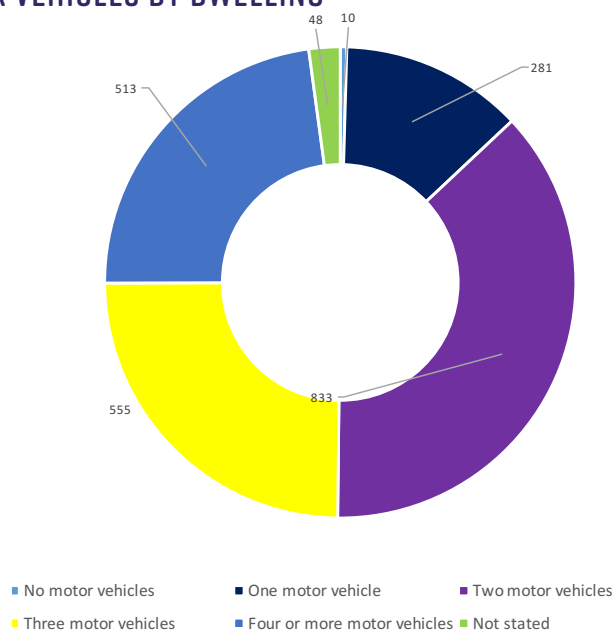
