Where it all started...


Back in February, a big group of locals—including community members, Elders, and service workers—came together for a half-day workshop to ask one big question:


"What would make the biggest difference for Central Logan's children right now?"

People loved the idea of a **100 Day Challenge**—a set period where community, services, local businesses and government all join forces to focus on one shared priority and create real change, together.









So, what did we decide to focus on?

After two big workshops full of great conversations and good food, here's the priority we agreed on:

Central Logan's "hardly heard" parents, carers and caregivers have increased opportunity to grow their safe and trusted connections.

That might look different for everyone—but we're focusing on four main areas where people find formal and informal connection and support:

- 1. Cultural & Family Connections
- 2. Health & Wellbeing Support
- 3. Community Hubs
- 4. Online Support Spaces

What's happening now?

We've pulled together a Steering Group made up of locals and services who are helping guide the next steps. We're still in the early stages and we're getting out and about to listen and learn from as many pockets of community as possible.

We'd love to come out and have a yarn about:

- What this priority means to you and your community
- Any good ideas you have—big or small
- Whether you or someone you know might want to get involved

There's no pressure—just a genuine invitation to be part of something that puts families and kids at the heart.
